I was both confused and disappointed by our last meeting and your most recent email. They certainly did not reflect the candidate you purported to be at forums or during the primary.

In the primary you portrayed yourself as an independent with fresh ideas, ready to make tough decisions for our city. Now however, you seem to be surrounded by and beholden to special interests and, either unwilling or unable to make independent decisions.

After months of campaigning, dozens of public forums and an endless number of questionnaires covering virtually every topic imaginable, you have correctly stated in your email to me that you are "*intimately aware of (my) platforms and plans for the office*". But then you add that you are still not ready to make a decision.

That kind of quid pro quo is offensive and unethical. It reminds me of the old line, self-serving, corrupt politics that I successfully fought against on the Orleans Parish School Board.

If you are the person I think you are, and like Eugene, Catherine and Andre, you will choose to support me because you think my views are more closely aligned with yours and your supporters. And, I welcome your support. If your endorsement comes with strings or a political quid pro quo, I am not your candidate.
